

Dear parent/guardian,

Sandringham College traditionally provides excursions/incursions that enhance or broaden the classroom-based learning experience of students. We believe that excursions/incursions should only be run where they offer an opportunity for students to:

- Extend their understanding of curriculum
- Solidify their understanding of key ideas and concepts being taught in the classroom
- Access the curriculum in a different form or format
- Be exposed to new ideas and ways of learning
- Make links between the curriculum and real-life applications of what they are learning
- Enhance their skills practically

In the past, we have always included the cost of excursions within the parent contribution amount for each subject and we have chosen to continue to do this for some subjects – Outdoor Education, French Language, Djeembana and VCAL.

For all other subjects we have chosen to not include the cost of excursions/incursions in the subject charges. We have chosen to do this due to the uncertain nature of the current COVID-19 environment. All curriculum-based excursions/incursions and associated costs will be communicated to parents via COMPASS Events.

PARENT PAYMENTS POLICY

ONE PAGE OVERVIEW

FREE INSTRUCTION

- Schools provide students with free instruction and ensure students have free access to all items, activities and services that are used by the school to fulfil the standard curriculum requirements in Victorian Curriculum F-10, VCE and VCAL.
- Schools may invite parents to make a financial contribution to support the school.

PARENT PAYMENT REQUESTS

Schools can request contributions from parents under three categories:

Curriculum Contributions Voluntary financial contributions for curriculum items and activities which the school deems necessary for students to learn the Curriculum. Other Contributions Voluntary financial contributions for noncurriculum items and activities that relate to the school's functions and objectives. Extra-Curricular Items and Activities

Items and activities that enhance or broaden the schooling experience of students and are above and beyond what the school provides for free to deliver the Curriculum. These are provided on a user-pays basis.

 Schools may also invite parents to supply or purchase educational items to use and own (e.g. textbooks, stationery, digital devices).

FINANCIAL HELP FOR FAMILIES

- Schools put in place financial hardship arrangements to support families who cannot pay for items or activities so that their child doesn't miss out.
- Schools have a nominated parent payment contact person(s) that parents can have a confidential discussion with regarding financial hardship arrangements.

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SCHOOL PROCESSES

• Schools must obtain school council approval for their parent payment arrangements and publish all requests and communications for each year level on their school website for transparency.
